- ★ The date and time have changed. We will now meet, still in the Session House, but on a **Thursday afternoon (2-4)**.
- ★ Please remember to bring a mask with you to wear during the meeting unless you are exempt on medical grounds.
- ★ If you have any Covid type symptoms, please do not attend the Guild in case you are positive and pass it on to others.
- ★ Please give your name and a contact telephone number or address when you arrive for Test and Protect. This information is kept for 21 days and then destroyed.
- ★ Hand sanitiser will be available for you to use on arrival and on leaving the meeting.
- ★ If you go to the toilet, please, as well as washing your hands, use the disinfectant provided to wipe hard surfaces.
- ★ If you develop symptoms after the meeting please get tested and if positive let Marie Campbell know as soon as possible.

This might all sound a bit scary and restrictive, but we want to make the meetings as safe as possible for all of our members and visitors.

The amount we have to pay to Guild headquarters has increased so this year we are asking members to pay £15 which will cover the capitation fee to 121, the one to Presbytery and your collection. Please put this in an envelope with your name on it and give it to Jean.
